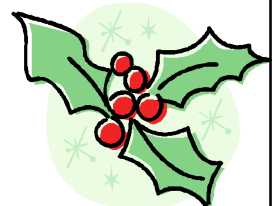

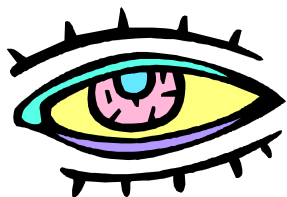

From 101: Take Ralston exit, travel west and cross El Camino. Continue for 1 1/2 miles and turn right on Avon, then left on Belburn

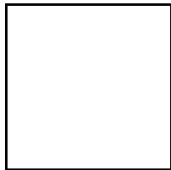
From 280: Take Ralston exit, travel east. Cross Alameda de las Pulgas, turn left on Avon, then left on Belburn.
